Number 2

Did you know that rainforests cover six percent of the Earth's surface and contain over half of the world's plant and animal species? Rainforests are divided into four layers. Let me explain them from top to bottom.

The top layer is called the emergent layer. It is made up of tall trees that can reach as high as 60 meters above the forest floor. Sunlight is plentiful up there. It can be very warm and windy. Here you can find eagles, monkeys, bats and butterflies.

Below the top layer is the canopy. It is the main layer of the rainforest and forms a roof over the two remaining layers. It's made up of dense leaves and branches. Many animals live in this layer since food is easy to find. Here you might find snakes, parrots and treefrogs.

The understory layer is below the canopy layer. Little sunshine reaches this layer, so the plants have to grow larger leaves to reach the sunlight. Jaguars, leopards, and the largest number of insects live in this layer.

The forest floor is the bottom layer. It is totally dark there as the dense trees cover everything, and only 2% of sunlight can reach the ground. There are deer, pigs, and giant anteaters there. This layer is the quietest layer as animals move around in the dark making little noise.

Rainforests are some of the most diverse places on Earth.
